



Mandatory RRP Rule Certification Training

DID YOU KNOW the EPA's new Renovation, Repair, & Painting (RRP) Rule requires most contractors and their companies to become RRP Certified?

The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) has issued a final rule that addresses lead based paint hazards created by renovation, repair, and painting activities. The requires renovation contractors, maintenance workers, painters*, and other specialty tradesmen who disturb painted surfaces during their work to become RRP certified.



This law will fully take effect on April 22, 2010. Renovators will be required to apply for certification from the EPA.
